HeartSaver /CPR Course

Course Description:

Designed to teach CPR and relief of foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) to all lay rescuers, particularly those who are expected to respond to emergencies in the workplace. This course does **not** fulfill requirements for Healthcare Providers (Physical therapists, CNAs, EMTs, etc) Participants will be trained in the skills of Adult, Child and Infant CPR and FBAO.

CPR/First Aid Course

Course Description:

Students will learn essential skills of patient care, understand the dangers of an emergency scene, and how to evaluate. Course is designed for Outfitters/Guides and other professionals who may be required to respond to emergencies on the job. It fulfills state credential requirements for licensing. This course is also designed for adults age 12 and up. This program satisfies OSHA requirements for industry, business, government and community.

Infant/Child CPR and First Aid

Course Description:

Designed for those who care for children, either fulltime or occasionally, this course teaches participants how to recognize and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies in infants and children up to 8 years old. Participants take home course completion cards as well as information about preventing injuries.
